





The 2013 ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest

October 23th - 25th, 2013

Introduction

The Final Round of the 2013 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site was held on Thursday October 24th, 2013 at BINUS UNIVERSITY with 63 teams participating consisted of 12 foreign teams (including teams from Taiwan, The Phillipines, Singapore, Vietnam, Hong Kong and Malaysia) and 51 national teams. The practice session was held on Wednesday October 23th, 2013.

Preparation and Registration

A national contest as a preparation contest had been held on October 13th, 2013, participated by 495 teams across Indonesia. Top 50 teams of the contest were awarded with a free pass to Asia Jakarta Regional Contest. On top of that 1 team has also advance to Asia Jakarta Regional Contest through Comfest UI competition.

The registration date closed on October 13th, 2013. The 63 teams participated in the final round of the contest are from 8 non-Indonesian universities and 14 Indonesian universities.

Opening Ceremony

The opening ceremony was held at 13:30 on Wednesday, October 23th, 2013 in the Auditorium of BINUS UNIVERSITY. It was attended by Vice Rectors, Deans and Head of Department of BINUS UNIVERSITY and also Prof. C.J. Hwang – ACM ICPC Asia Director, as the special guest of the ceremony.

After Vice Rector's welcoming teams & coaches, Prof. Hwang gave a very inspiring speech for the contestants. Fredy Purnomo, S.Kom., M.Kom., as the Regional Contest Director of the The 2013 ACM-ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest then opened the ceremony together with Prof. C.J. Huang and BINUS Leaders by hitting a gong. The event continued with teams introduction to all attendees of the ceremony by Santy, S.Kom., M.Sc., Chairperson of The 2013 ACM-ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest. Technical Briefing on the practice session and the contest which summarized the opening ceremony was given by Mr. Suhendry Effendy, S.Kom., as the Chief of Judge.

Practice Session

The Practice Session was started at 15:30 PM until 16:30 and attended by the registered teams. The session was well run and finish in time.

Final Round

The Final Round of the contest started at 09:30 on Thursday, October 24th, 2013 and finished at 14:30 PM. Only 61 teams were presented, 2 teams from Indonesian universities were not present. The system ran smoothly during the entire contest. During the contest, contestants were also provided with free snacks and drinks. After the contest finished, all attendees, including contestants, coaches, committees and volunteers were provided with lunch. While waiting for the awarding ceremony all registered teams were taken to know BINUS UNIVERSITY more than just the contest area. Teams were introduced to the library, food court and other facilities of BINUS UNIVERSITY.

Awarding Ceremony

The Awarding Ceremony was held in Auditorium of BINUS UNIVERSITY. It was attended by all 61 teams along with all BINUS UNIVERSITY leaders, Prof. CJ. Huang, Ir. Tifatul Sembiring (Minister of Communication and Informatics for Republic of Indonesia), and representatives from the sponsors: Mr. Tan Wijaya from IBM, Mr. Natali Ardianto from Tiket.com and Mr. Derianto Kusuma from Traveloka, and also other invited guests of the University. It started with Indonesian traditional dance and continued with speech by BINUS UNIVERSITY'S CEO, Mr. Bernard Gunawan, which then continued with the speech from Ir. Tifatul Sembiring (Minister of Communication and Informatics for Republic of Indonesia). The event continued with the presentations from IBM and Tiket.com

Chief of Judge, Mr. Suhendry, S.Kom. gave statistics of the problem solved, announced the honorable mentions and rank 15 to 4 and then announced the names of the winning teams. The prizes were distributed to Best Top 3 and Best National Teams of ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest and also to Top 3 Indonesia National Contest. The Best Top 3 of ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest were won by (in rank order) ThanQ (from National University of Singapore, solved 8 problems out of 10), Kirino: P (from National Taiwan University, solved 7 problems out of 10) and Runes of Champion team (from FPT University, solved 7 problems out of 10).

While for Best National Teams was won by Vidina 2.0 (from University of Indonesia) Vidina 2.0 had solved 6 problems out of 10 and was at the 6th place on the overall rank list.

Prof. C.J. Huang made a speech congratulating the winners and encouraging those who have not yet succeed to win the competition. Prof. C.J. Huang also mentioned the importance role of government and industry in supporting the event and thank all the participating parties of the event.

The celebration was ended at 7.00 PM with a dinner party for all participants.

Excursion

On the 25th of October 2013, the Final Round of the 2013 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site activity series was ended with a day-trip excursion to few of the main tourism spots in Jakarta, Bank of Indonesia Museum, National Monuments of Indonesia, and Grand Indonesia Shopping Town. Though not all teams were able to participate in this excursion due to the flight schedule, the many participating teams were excited to learn the diverse culture, history and growing economy of Indonesia. The excursion started at 7am and ended at 9pm. This pleasant activity has wrapped up the successfully held event series, The 2013 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site.
