





The 2010 ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest

November 30th – December 1st, 2010

Introduction

The Final Round of the 2010 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site was held on Wednesday December 1^{st} , 2010 at BINUS UNIVERSITY with 66 teams participating consisted of 16 foreign teams (including teams from Singapore, China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Thailand and Japan) and 50 national teams. The practice session was held on Tuesday December 30^{th} , 2010.

Preparation and Registration

A national contest as a preparation contest had been held on November 7th, 2010, participated by 220 teams across Indonesia. Top 50 teams of the contest were awarded with a free pass to Asia Jakarta Regional Contest.

The registration date closed on November 10th, 2010. The top 50 teams of Indonesia National Contest participated in the Asia Jakarta Regional Contest. Teams are from 7 non-Indonesian universities and 12 Indonesian universities on the Final Round of the contest.

Opening Ceremony

The opening ceremony was held at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, November 30th, 2010 in the Auditorium of BINUS UNIVERSITY. It was attended by CEO of BINUS GROUP Ir. Bernard Gunawan, Vice Rectors, Deans and Head of Department of BINUS UNIVERSITY as special guests of the ceremony.

After Rector's welcoming teams & coaches, Ir. Sablin Yusuf, MSc., MCompSc as the Regional Contest Director of the The 2010 ACM-ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest opened the ceremony and continued with teams introduction to all attendees of the ceremony. Technical Briefing on the practice session and the contest was given by Mr. Win Ce, S.Kom., MM as the Chief of Judge. The Opening Ceremony was ended with lunch.

Practice Session

After lunch, the Practice Session was started at 12:00 PM until 1:30 PM and attended by all registered teams. The session was well run and finish in time. The 1st day was ended with excursion to Grand Indonesia Mall. Excursions were scheduled to visit either Monas or Grand Indonesia, due to bad weather condition, excursion to Monas was canceled.

Final Round

The Final Round of the contest started at 9:00 AM on Wednesday, December 1st, 2010 and finished at 2:00 PM. Only 60 teams were presented, 6 teams from Indonesian universities were not presented due to financial problems. The system ran smoothly during the contest, and there were no problems found with the pc^2, both on the judges' terminals and the contestants. Only 1 problem with printer jam was noticed and can be fixed in time but no intrusion to the contest was detected.

During the contest, contestants were also provided with free snacks and drinks. After the contest finished, all attendees, including contestants, coaches, committees and volunteers were provided with lunch. While waiting for the awarding ceremony all registered teams were taken to know BINUS UNIVERSITY more than just the contest area. Teams were introduced to the library, food court and other facilities of BINUS UNIVERSITY. Teams were also taken to local sponsors' booth to fill survey questionnaires from the sponsor. The questionnaires would be randomly chosen to get door prize as part of the closing ceremony.

Awarding Ceremony

The Awarding Ceremony was held in Auditorium of BINUS UNIVERSITY. It was attended by all 60 teams along with all BINUS UNIVERSITY leaders and invited guests of the University. IBM representative could not attend the ceremony, due to unavailability. It started with Indonesian traditional dance and continued with speech by BINUS UNIVERSITY'S CEO and another speech by APTIKOM (Association of Computer Studies Universities in Indonesia) representative.

Then the Chief of Judge Mr. Win Ce, S.Kom., MM announced the names of the winning teams. The prizes were distributed to Best Top 3 and 3 Best National Teams. The Best Top 3 were won by (in rank order) +1ironwood Team (from National Taiwan University solved 9 problems out of 10), Halo Team (from Shanghai Jiaotong University solved 9 problems out of 10) and ManiAC team (from Chinese University of Hong Kong 9 problems out of 10).

While for 3 Best National Teams were won by Saklar Lhompat (from University of Indonesia), Dongskar Pedongi II Team (from Institut Teknologi Bandung) and Hope Team (from BINUS UNIVERSITY). Saklar Lhompat had solved 8 problems out of 10 and was at the 8th place on the overall rank list. Dongskar Pedongi II had solved 8 problems out of 10 and was at the 9th place on the overall rank list. Hope had solved 7 problems out of 10 and was at the 11th place on the overall rank list.

One reward should be made to Yummy Bomb team from Shanghai Jiaotong University as all female team had solved 9 problems out of 10 and was at 4th place on the overall rank list.

The celebration was ended at 7.00 PM with a dinner party for all participants.
