The 2012 ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest

October 16th – 18th, 2012

Introduction

The Final Round of the 2012 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site was held on Wednesday October 17th, 2012 at BINUS UNIVERSITY with 63 teams participating consisted of 13 foreign teams (including teams from Singapore, China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Thailand and The Phillipines) and 50 national teams. The practice session was held on Tuesday October 16th, 2012.

Preparation and Registration

A national contest as a preparation contest had been held on September 30th, 2010, participated by 456 teams across Indonesia. Top 50 teams of the contest were awarded with a free pass to Asia Jakarta Regional Contest.

The registration date closed on October 6th, 2012. The 63 teams participated in the final round of the contest are from 9 non-Indonesian universities and 14 Indonesian universities.

Opening Ceremony

The opening ceremony was held at 09:30 AM on Tuesday, October 16th, 2012 in the Auditorium of BINUS UNIVERSITY. It was attended by CEO of BINUS GROUP Ir. Bernard Gunawan, Vice Rectors, Deans and Head of Department of BINUS UNIVERSITY as special guests of the ceremony.

After Vice Rector's welcoming teams & coaches, Fredy Purnomo, S.Kom., M.Kom., as the Regional Contest Director of the The 2012 ACM-ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest opened the ceremony and continued with teams introduction to all attendees of the ceremony by Santy, S.Kom., M.Sc., Chairman of The 2012 ACM-ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest. Technical Briefing on the practice session and the contest was given by Mr. Suhendry Effendy, S.Kom., as the Chief of Judge. The Opening Ceremony was ended with lunch.

Practice Session

After lunch, the Practice Session was started at 12:00 PM until 1:30 PM and attended by all registered teams. The session was well run and finish in time.

Final Round

The Final Round of the contest started at 9:00 AM on Wednesday, October 17th, 2012 and finished at 2:00 PM. Only 58 teams were presented, 5 teams from Indonesian universities were not present. The system ran smoothly during the entire contest. During the contest, contestants were also provided with free snacks and drinks. After the contest finished, all attendees, including contestants, coaches, committees and volunteers were provided with lunch. While waiting for the awarding ceremony all registered teams were taken to know BINUS UNIVERSITY more than just the contest area. Teams were introduced to the library, food court and other facilities of BINUS UNIVERSITY.

Awarding Ceremony

The Awarding Ceremony was held in Auditorium of BINUS UNIVERSITY. It was attended by all 58 teams along with all BINUS UNIVERSITY leaders and invited guests of the University. IBM representative could not attend the ceremony, due to unavailability. It started with Indonesian traditional dance and continued with speech by BINUS UNIVERSITY's CEO and another speech by Dr. Ashwin Sasongko, M.Sc., Directorate General of Telematics Applications, Indonesia Ministry of Communication and Information Technology.

Then, the Chief of Judge Mr. Suhendry, S.Kom. gave statistics of the problem solved, announced the honorable mentions and rank 15 to 4 and then announced the names of the winning teams. The prizes were distributed to Best Top 3 and 3 Best National Teams of ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest and also to Top 3 Indonesia National Contest. The Best Top 3 of ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest were won by (in rank order) +1ironwood Team (from National Taiwan University, solved 10 problems out of 10), Dongskar Pedongi (from Institut Teknologi Bandung, solved 7 problems out of 10) and Eternia team (from National University of Singapore, solved 7 problems out of 10).

While for 3 Best National Teams were won by Dongskar Pedongi (from Institut Teknologi Bandung), Saklar Lhompat (from University of Indonesia) and Vidina 2.0 Team (from University of Indonesia). Dongskar Pedongi had solved 7 problems out of 10 and was at the 2nd place on the overall rank list. Saklar Lhompat had solved 6 problems out of 10 and was at the 6th place on the overall rank list. Vidina 2.0 had solved 5 problems out of 10 and was at the 10th place on the overall rank list.

The celebration was ended at 7.00 PM with a dinner party for all participants.

Excursion

On the 18th of October 2012, the Final Round of the 2012 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site activity series was ended with a day-trip excursion to one of the main tourism spot in Jakarta, Taman Mini Indonesia Indah (TMII). Though not all teams were able to participate in this excursion due to the flight schedule, the many participating teams were excited to learn the diverse culture of Indonesia presented in TMII. The excursion started at 7am and ended at 3.30pm. This pleasant activity has wrapped up the successfully held event series, The 2012 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site.
