The 2014 ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest

December 4th – 6th, 2014

Introduction

The Final Round of the 2014 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site was held on Friday, December 5th, 2014 at BINUS UNIVERSITY with 70 teams participating consisted of 15 foreign teams (including teams from Taiwan, Japan, Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, and Singapore) and 55 national teams. The practice session was held on Thursday, December 4th, 2014.

Preparation and Registration

A national contest as a preparation contest had been held on November, 9th, 2014, participated by 307 teams across Indonesia. Top 50 teams of the contest were awarded with a free pass to Asia Jakarta Regional Contest. On top of that 4 teams has also advance to Asia Jakarta Regional Contest through IDEA FUSE and 1 team from Comfest UI competition.

Opening Ceremony

The opening ceremony was held at 09:30 on Thursday, December 4th, 2014 in the Auditorium of BINUS UNIVERSITY. It was attended by BINUS Group's CEO, BINUS University's Vice Rectors, Deans and Head of Department of BINUS UNIVERSITY and also representatives from IBM and Jatis Group, as the keynote speakers of the ceremony.

After Vice Rector's welcoming teams & coaches, Yen Lina Prasetyo S.Kom., M.CompSc., as the Regional Contest Director of the The 2014 ACM-ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest gave an opening speech which then continued by speech and presentation from Panji Wasmana from IBM Indonesia and Jusuf from Jatis Group. The event continued with teams introduction to all attendees of the ceremony by Alvina Aulia, S.Kom., MTI., Chairperson of The 2014 ACM-ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest. Technical Briefing on the practice session and the contest which summarized the opening ceremony was given by Mr. Suhendry Effendy, S.Kom., as the Chief of Judge.

Practice Session

The Practice Session was started at 15:30 PM until 16:30 and attended by the registered teams. The session was well run and finish in time.

Final Round

The Final Round of the contest started at 13:30 on Friday, December 5th, 2014 and finished at 18:30 PM. Only 69 teams were presented, 1 foreign team was not present. The system ran smoothly during the entire contest. During the contest, contestants were also provided with free snacks and drinks. After the contest finished, all attendees, including contestants, coaches, committees and volunteers were provided with dinner. While waiting for the awarding ceremony all registered teams were taken to know BINUS UNIVERSITY more than just the contest area and visit several booths of the sponsors which inform them about their products and opportunities within the companies. Teams were also introduced to the library, food court and other facilities of BINUS UNIVERSITY.

Awarding Ceremony

The Awarding Ceremony was held in Auditorium of BINUS UNIVERSITY. It was attended by all 61 teams along with all BINUS UNIVERSITY leaders, Dr. Hj. Istaryatiningtyas (Deputy Head of Education Department of DKI Jakarta Province), and representatives from the sponsors : Mr. On Lee from GDP Venture, Mr. Derianto Kusuma from Traveloka, and also other invited guests of the University. It started with a traditional dance and continued with speech by Dr. Hj. Istaryatiningtyas, which then continued with the speech from Mr. On Lee from GDP Venture. Chief of Judge, Mr. Suhendry, S.Kom. then gave statistics of the problem solved, announced the honorable mentions and rank 15 to 4 and then announced the names of the winning teams. The prizes were distributed to Best Top 3 and Best National Teams of ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest and also to Top 3 Indonesia National Contest. The Best Top 3 of ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest were won by (in rank order) ThanQ (from National University of Singapore, solved 11 problems out of 11), Team X (from Korea University, also solved 11 problems out of 11) and Java# team (from VNU University of Engineering and Technology, solved 11 problems out of 11).

While for Best National Teams was won by BerinGAS (from University of Indonesia) BerinGAS had solved 9 problems out of 11 and was at the 4th place on the overall rank list. The celebration was ended at 22.00 PM with photo sessions for all participants and committee.

Excursion

On the 6th of December 2014, the Final Round of the 2014 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site activity series was ended with a day-trip excursion to few of the main tourism spots in Jakarta, National Monuments of Indonesia, National Museum of Indonesia, Museum Perumusan Naskah Proklamasi, and Sarinah Shopping Centre. Though not all teams were able to participate in this excursion due to the flight schedule and many other reasons, the many participating teams were excited to learn the diverse culture, history and growing economy of Indonesia. The excursion started at 7am and ended at 6pm. This pleasant activity has wrapped up the successfully held event series, The 2014 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site.
