## The 2016 ACM ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest

*November 6<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup>, 2016*

### **Introduction**

The Final Round of the 2016 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site was held on Sunday November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at BINUS UNIVERSITY with 73 teams participating consisted of 16 foreign teams (including teams from Singapore, Korea, Japan, Taiwan, China, Vietnam, and Phillipines) and 57 national teams. The practice session was held on Sunday November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

### **Preparation and Registration**

A national contest as a preparation contest had been held on October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2016, participated by 424 teams across Indonesia. The Top 50 teams of the contest were awarded with a free pass to Asia Jakarta Regional Contest.

The registration date closed on October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The top 50 teams of Indonesia National Contest participated in the Asia Jakarta Regional Contest. Teams are from 9 non-Indonesian universities and 14 Indonesian universities on the Final Round of the contest.

### **Opening Ceremony**

The opening ceremony was held at 08:45 AM on Sunday, November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016 in the Auditorium of BINUS UNIVERSITY. It was attended by BINUS Group's CEO, BINUS University's Vice Rector, Dean and Head of Department of BINUS UNIVERSITY and also representatives from IBM as the keynote speakers of the ceremony.

After Vice Rector's welcoming teams & coaches, Yen Lina Prasetyo S.Kom., M.CompSc., as the Regional Contest Director of the The 2016 ACM-ICPC Asia Jakarta Regional Contest gave an opening speech which then continued by Technical Briefing on the practice session and the contest which summarized the opening ceremony was given by Mr. Suhendry Effendy, S.Kom., as the Chief of Judge. The Opening Ceremony was ended with notebook checking and practice session.

### **Practice Session**

The Practice Session was started at 10:00 AM until 11:30 AM and attended by all registered teams. The session was well run and finish before the designated time.

### **Final Round**

The Final Round of the contest started at 01:00 PM on Sunday, November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and finished at 06:00 PM. The system ran smoothly during the contest, and there were no problems found with the pc<sup>2</sup>, both on the judges' terminals and the contestants.

During the contest, contestants were also provided with free snacks and drinks. After the contest finished, all attendees, including contestants, coaches, committees and volunteers were provided with lunch. While waiting for the awarding ceremony all registered teams were taken to know BINUS UNIVERSITY more than just the contest area. Teams were introduced to the library, food court and other facilities of BINUS UNIVERSITY.

### **Awarding Ceremony**

The Awarding Ceremony was held in Auditorium of BINUS UNIVERSITY. It was attended by all registered teams along with all BINUS UNIVERSITY leaders. The ceremony then continued with speech by BINUS UNIVERSITY's CEO and then the Chief of Judge Mr. Suhendry Effendy, S.Kom., announced the names of the winning teams. The prizes were distributed to Best Top 3 and 1 Best National Team. The Best Top 3 were won by (in rank order) AcThPaUNpPuAmCmBkCfEsFn Team (from National Taiwan University solved 12 problems out of 12), TeamTam Team (from National University of Singapore solved 10 problems out of 12) and LINUX Team (from University of Engineering and Technology solved 10 problems out of 12). While for The Best National Team was won by Awrakin Team from University of Indonesia. The celebration was ended at 09.30 PM with photo sessions and a dinner party for all participants.

### **Excursion**

On the 7<sup>th</sup> of November 2016, the Final Round of the 2016 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site activity series was ended with a day-trip excursion to few of the main tourism spots in Puncak, Taman Bunga Nusantara, Roofpark, and Cimory Riverside. Though not all teams were able to participate in this excursion due to the flight schedule and many other reasons, the many participating teams were excited to learn the diverse culture, history and growing economy of Indonesia. The excursion started at 07.00 AM and ended at 05.00 PM. This pleasant activity has wrapped up the successfully held event series, The 2016 ACM-ICPC Asia Regional Jakarta Site
